Peregrino Sauvignon Blanc - Chile	£4.60 / £6.50 / £18.50
<i>Well-balanced with restrained aromatics of citrus and minerals, this has lemony acidity and a lightly herbal finish. Enjoy with Greek salad, squid or chickpeas.</i>	
Kleindal Chenin Blanc - South Africa	£5.50/ £6.50 / £18.95
<i>Subtle notes of fruit salad and white stone fruit with a textured, well-rounded palate.</i>	
San Georgio Pinot Grigio - Italy	£5.00 / £6.75 / £20
<i>A very classic Pinot Grigio with notes of nuts, pear, melon and even a hint of banana. This is beautifully balanced with fresh citrus acidity and a nutty finish.</i>	
Groote Post Unwooded Chardonnay - South Africa	£5.75 / £8 / £23
<i>Pineapple, citrus flavours are in abundance on the nose and palate. This vintage has fresh acidity and concentrated structure with very good ageing potential.</i>	
Makutu Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand	£5.85 / £8.25 / £24
<i>Mellow layers of ripe gooseberries & asparagus with a crisp, yet friendly acidity make this a delight to drink either with food or on its own.</i>	
Casa Silva Reserva Viognier - Chile	£5.85 / £8.25 / £24
<i>Rich, voluptuous & full of juicy flavours of nectarines & apricots this has a lovely balance of acidity too.</i>	
La Val Orballo albarino - Spain	£5.85 / £8.25 / £24
<i>Aromas of stone fruit, honey & floral notes mingling with wild herbs, sweeter mandarin skin & apple. Generous on the palate with hints of ripe gala melon, salinity and fresh citrus.</i>	
Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de la Serre - Languidoc, France	£6 / £8.50 / £24
<i>An appealing nose of melon and orange with a sprinkling of spice and white pepper. The palate is fresh and dry but with a nice weight of fruit, well-balanced and long.</i>	
The Crossings Pinot Gris - New Zealand	£25
<i>Flavours of white peach with hints of pear, honey and tropical fruit. Elegant and beautifully balanced with a crisp mouth-watering finish.</i>	
Sancerre, Domaine Sylvian Bailly - Loire, France	£30
<i>The Sauvignon Blanc for his Sancerre is grown on both chalky soils on the upper hillsides, which have very little top soil, and clay based soils, which have a little chalk. The chalky soils lend finesse and intensity, whilst the clayey soils provide richness and the ability to age.</i>	
Chablis l'Onciale - Burgundy, France	£7.50 / £10.50 / £30
<i>Distinctly nutty with grilled nuts, toasted chestnuts and citrus fresh lemon acidity. This is focused and still youthful but with complexing development.</i>	
Pouilly Fuisse, Vieilles Vignes, Collovrays et Terrier - Burgundy, France	£40
<i>A fresh, pure expression of the Burgundian white grape, Chardonnay, with floral aromas and a rich complex palate.</i>	
Meursault 1er Cru Chateau de Blagny, Louis Latour - Burgundy, France	£60
<i>From Latour's Monopole (100% ownership) vineyard in Mersault. It reveals a floral nose, slightly buttery with hints of fresh almond and hazelnut. The palate is round with a lively finish.</i>	

Rose Wine

Willowood White Zinfandel - U.S.A	£5.00 / £6.75 / £20
<i>A lively, fruity Rose with aromas of red summer fruits and an attractive crisp sweetness on the palate.</i>	
Sartori Pinot Grigio Rose - Italy	£5.25 / £6.95 / £21
<i>A superbly fresh and fashionable blush wine - amber pink in colour with hints of pear and apricot.</i>	
Le Chemin de Provence - Aix en Provence, France	£5.85 / £8.25 / £24
<i>On the nose, red fruits like raspberries and strawberries, with more exotic fruits like guava in the background. The palate is fresh and clean, emphasizing ripe strawberries and perfectly balanced acidity.</i>	

Red Wine

Peregrino Merlot - Chile	£4.40 / £5.75 / £17.50
<i>A juicy wine bursting with lots of blue and purple fruit such as blackberries and blueberries and also some raspberry. This is soft and approachable with mellow tannins.</i>	
Raka Figurehead Pinotage - South Africa	£28
<i>Bold red with a lovely spiciness and lots of dark fruits. Rich, long finish.</i>	
Sierra Alta Malbec - Argentina	£5.50 / £7.50 / £22
<i>A vibrant and juicy Malbec made from grapes grown at high altitude in Mendoza. Flavours of black cherry, ripe plum and hints of chocolate over supple tannins.</i>	
Head over Heals Shiraz - Australia	£5 / £6.75 / £20
<i>A mouthfilling combination of blackberries, coffee and subtle vanilla oak making this a superb Shiraz from Oz.</i>	
Los Vinateros Crianza - Spain	£5.25 / £7.30 / £21
<i>Very appealing aromas of dill, coconut and succulent red fruit and brambles. Spicy, warm and rounded this has well balanced tannins and a good length.</i>	
Domaine mas Barrau Cabernet Franc - France	£5.85 / £8.25 / £24
<i>Soft & juicy filled with plums & soft red fruits this is tinged with sweet peppers & 'Provence' spices. This is classic French yet modern in style.</i>	
Neptune Point Pinot Noir - New Zealand	£5.75 / £8 / £23
<i>Medium depth of colour with attractive spicy berry and bramble fruits along with black cherry notes. This is a classic Pinot Noir with well integrated tannins and a good length.</i>	
McPherson Don't Tell Gary Shiraz - New Zealand	£28
<i>Fruit for the DTG Shiraz was sourced from a single vineyard established in 1998 in the rugged, mountainous Grampians region of Victoria. Black cherry, blueberry and mixed spice added to hints of pepper and soft oak spice are beautifully integrated.</i>	
Faustino 1 Rioja - Spain	£35
<i>Clean, bright. On the nose is complex and elegant, wide fruity and spicy notes. On the mouth, elegant, with pleasant hints due to the barrel ageing. Long and silky finish.</i>	
Domaine Jones Fitou - Languidoc, France	£30
<i>Complex, smooth and succulent, with pure hedgerow fruit. Domaine Jones Fitou is made from grapes from 15 of very small vineyards. The secret of this Fitou is that most of them are over 100 years old and bring freshness, depth and a beautiful texture to the wine.</i>	
Reserve des Argentiers, Chateaufort du Pape - Rhone, France	£38
<i>The wine has a complex bouquet with fruits and spices (thyme, rosemary and pepper) followed by a long, rewarding, silky finish.</i>	
Barolo Cascina Adelaide - Piedmont, Italy	£50
<i>A superb Barolo, with aromas of orange skin, plums, and Tobacco leaves.</i>
